Dear Mr. Jensen:

The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the sites listed above and determined that nearly all the sites should be re-designated as No Action Sites, rather than carrying a No Further Action determination. The exception, MISC-015, initially appears to represent a site that poses no potential risk to human health or the environment. However, the site is located within the Naval Gun Range firing fan and will most likely be surveyed under the same remedial/geophysical activities as the rest of the Gun Range ordnance site and will have institutional controls. Therefore, MISC-015 should remain as a No Further Action site pending the removal of those institutional controls.
